2017 Orange County Law Enforcement Memorial Service set for Friday

Ceremony pays tribute to fallen police officers and their families

Goshen, N.Y. –Orange County Executive Steven M. Neuhaus is encouraging residents to attend the 2017 Orange County Law Enforcement Memorial Service on Friday, May 5th.

“This service provides us with the opportunity to pay tribute to law enforcement officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice to protect the residents of Orange County,” Neuhaus said. “As County Executive, I fully support the men and women who risk their lives every day to ensure our safety. This event gives our County a meaningful way to show our support and gratitude as a community.”

The service will be held at 6:00 p.m. at the entrance to the Orange County Courthouse in Goshen. The annual event honors Orange County law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty and whose names have been enshrined on two memorial walls outside the courthouse.

Featured speakers at the event will include Neuhaus, Orange County District Attorney Dave Hoovler and Sheriff Carl E. DuBois. The service, which also pays tribute to the families of fallen law enforcement officers, will last approximately one hour. It is open to all members of the law enforcement community and to the general public. A reception will be held in the courthouse lobby after the service.
