Advisory: Sally's Dream Playground closed until June 26th for renovations

Goshen, N.Y. – Sally’s Dream Playground, located at Thomas Bull Memorial Park in Montgomery, will be closed for renovations until June 26th.

Sally’s Dream, a handicapped accessible playground, is one of the most popular facilities in Orange County’s park system. It will be closed so that the new playground equipment can be installed to offer even more accessibility for children. It was built in 2002 in memory of Sarah “Sally” McGlynn.

McGlynn, who was passed away in 1999, was one of the founders and a board member of The Family Empowerment Council, a nonprofit agency founded by parents of disabled children to provide services for people with disabilities in Orange and Sullivan counties. McGlynn was an advocate for the disabled for 30 years and was influential in developing local independent living centers. Funds were raised by a few organizations to build the playground in her honor.
