Tips that will help spectators enjoy the New York Air Show

Decorated U.S. Navy Blue Angels will headline the event on July 1-2 at Stewart

Airport in Newburgh

Goshen, N.Y. – The U.S. Navy Blue Angels jet demonstration squadron will headline the 2017 New York Air Show on July 1-2 at Stewart International Airport in New Windsor.

Here are some tips and frequently asked questions that will help spectators enjoy the show safely:

- Gates open each day at 9:00 a.m. and close at 5:00 p.m. Flight performances take place from Noon to 4:00 p.m.
- If you leave the air show, re-entry to the event is not allowed.
- Wear comfortable shoes and be prepared to walk. The runway at Stewart Airport is lengthy.
- Sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat are all recommended for protection from the sun.
- Hearing protection, especially for children is also recommended. Ear plugs are available at the New York Air Show.
- Due to security regulations, coolers, outside food and beverages, canteens, camelbacks, weapons of any kind, tent structures, self-standing umbrellas

- are all prohibited. If you arrive to the front gate with any of these items, you will be directed by security to return them to your car or to discard them in a trash receptacle. For the safety of the attendees and the animals, pets are not allowed with the exception of service animals.
- Spectators will be allowed to bring one sealed bottle of water per person, no
 larger than one liter in size. If a patron has special medical restrictions, items
 will be allowed in reasonable quantities if accompanied by a doctor's note.
 You will be asked to present your doctor's note to security upon entry to the
 event.
- Personal, handheld umbrellas will be allowed into the event. Self-standing umbrellas and tent structures are strictly prohibited due to safety.
- Backpacks are allowed and will be subject to security inspection upon entrance into the Air Show.
- Parking is \$15 if purchased in advance or \$20 at the event.
- You cannot use your Saturday ticket for Sunday or vice versa. If you would like to change the date of your ticket, please reach out to our box office by telephone at 877.766.8158 or email at newyorkairshow@completeticketsolutions.com.
- In the event of non-authorized intervention, weather or other causes beyond our control, the event may be terminated or suspended and tickets are non-refundable. If the event is cancelled in its entirety on Saturday due to weather, tickets will be honored on Sunday. If the event is cancelled in its entirety on Sunday or for the weekend due to weather, tickets will be refunded or honored at the 2018 event.

Handicapped Parking and Accessibility Information

- All public areas of the Air Show are handicapped accessible. Wheelchairs and scooters will not be available for rent, but you are more than welcome to bring your own.
- Handicapped parking will be available in all official air show parking lots. If required, shuttle service will be available to accommodate wheelchairs with service to and from the entrance of the air show.

Veterans Parking Shuttle

Orange County's Veterans Service Agency (VSA) will provide veterans with complimentary rides from the shuttle bus drop-off to the show entrance before and after the event.
